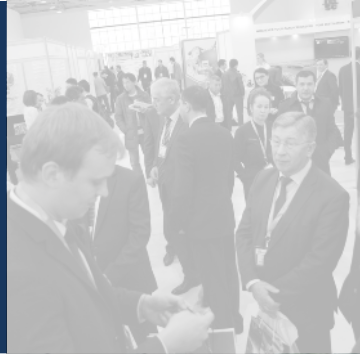

Some near future prospects:



657 projects to be implemented in the country.
Investments: USD 40 billion, from 2017 to 2022.

150 projects on development of automobile roads, railways,
and logistics centres.
Investments: USD 10 billion, from 2015 to 2019.



8 new metro stations to be built in Tashkent.
Investments: USD 295 million, from 2017 to 2020.

Tashkent ring-road suburban train.
Investments: USD 189 million, from 2017 to 2030.

Increased electrification of railway lines 34% to 51%,
from 2015 to 2020.

New railway line Angren-Pap
(transit corridor section China-Central Asia-Europe),
including a 19 km tunnel, operated since 2016.



Increased production of fruit and vegetables from 17 to 32
million tons per year, from 2016 to 2020.



77 projects on textile industry development.
Investments: USD 918 million, from 2015 to 2019.



54 projects in oil and gas sector.
Investments: more than USD 7 billion, from 2015 to 2019.
